Pursuant to Iowa Code section 299A.3, the filing (by a parent, guardian, or legal or actual custodian) of the annual report under section 299.4 and the annual assessment under section 299A.4 is optional. This form may be used on a voluntary basis to inform a local school district that a resident child of compulsory school attendance age is receiving competent private instruction in accordance with Iowa Code section 299A.3, without filing Form A or end-of-school-year assessment results. In filing this form, the parent, guardian, or legal or actual custodian relinquishes access to public school dual enrollment for academics, extracurricular activities, or special education services.

3) **Days of Instruction.** A child receiving private instruction under Iowa Code section 299A.3 will be considered to be receiving competent private instruction under Iowa Code chapter 299A. Iowa Code section 299A.2(a) requires a student receiving competent private instruction to be given such instruction for at least 148 days per school year, and filing this form is an indication that the private instruction provided to the child complies with this requirement.

4) **Plan of Instruction.** Filing this form is an indication that the child will receive private instruction using a plan and course of study, as required by the Iowa Code.
