

NICHE has compiled a list of accredited correspondence schools whose final report should be accepted by the Department of Education and resident school districts as an end-of-year annual assessment report to satisfy the requirements of Competent Private Instruction (CPI) Option 2 with Opt-In Reporting.

This list is neither guaranteed nor exhaustive but is provided as a tool to assist you. Parents using correspondence school reports as evidence of annual educational progress bear the responsibility of confirming that the school they use is appropriately accredited and has maintained this accreditation while the student was enrolled.

Homeschooling parents using a legal option other than CPI Option 2 with Opt-In Reporting can also use one of these accredited correspondence schools, if desired, but the end-of-year report would not need to be filed with the resident public school district.

- Decide whether you and your child can commit to all of the correspondence school's requirements, including costs, curriculum choices, and timelines for completion.
- Verify that the correspondence school's worldview is compatible with your own.
- Certify, each year you use the correspondence school for annual assessment purposes, that the school is appropriately accredited and obtain printed verification of this fact.
- Understand that utilizing end-of-year reports from accredited correspondence schools for competent private instruction annual assessment purposes does not automatically ensure that credits earned through an accredited correspondence school can be transferred to a public school, if you should ever desire to do so.
