

**ASSURANCE OF ELIGIBILITY
OF A
STUDENT UNDER COMPETENT PRIVATE INSTRUCTION (CPI)**

The 281–36.15(280) eligibility rules for the State of Iowa require that the following conditions be met for a student under Competent Private Instruction to participate in interscholastic competition:

1. The student must receive credit in at least four subjects.
2. The student must pass all coursework for which credit is given.
3. The student must be under 20 years of age.
4. The student must be dual enrolled and in good standing with the student’s high school that is a member or associate member, also in good standing, of the organization sponsoring the event.
