

Acceptable Tests for Annual Assessment of Students Under Competent Private Instruction (CPI) with Reporting & Annual Assessment

If the parent of a student under **CPI with Reporting & Annual Assessment** determines to use a **standardized test** as the annual assessment tool, the Iowa Administrative Code (281-31.4(1)) states that the following may be utilized:

- a. A nationally recognized standardized achievement evaluation; or
- b. Another assessment tool selected by the child's parent, guardian, or legal custodian from an approved list provided by the department of education.

Standardized assessments approved by the Iowa Department of Education are:

- The Iowa Test of Basic Skills - Form E and F (2017 norms);
- The Terra Nova - 3rd Edition, Forms C and D (2017 norms);
- The Stanford Achievement Test - 10th Edition (2018 norms); and
- The ISASP - Iowa State Assessment of Student Progress.

Parents may request standardized testing from their school district, if desired.

Parents can also opt to purchase an approved standardized assessment from an accredited private test provider (e.g. Bob Jones University Testing). If the test publisher determines that the parent is a qualified administrator, he or she can administer the assessment.
